



SPECIES & GRADES OF HEAVY TIMBER (4" Thick or Greater) COMMONLY STOCKED IN THE REGION FOR MANUFACTURE OF TRUSSES OR WOOD ACCENT PIECES

SPECIES	GRADE	DRYNESS STATUS
Southern Yellow Pine	No. 1, No. 2	Green or Kiln-Dried
Douglas Fir	No. 1	Green
Western Red Cedar	Appearance Grade, No. 1	Green
Bald Cypress	Normally Not Graded	Green or Kiln-Dried

NOTES:

1. Other grades (Ex: Select Structural) can be sourced, but may involve special mill orders from the west coast or other regions.
2. Douglas Fir and Western Red Cedar are inherently dry material and the moisture content of green timbers is relatively lower than other species.
